FACT SHEET ON NEW BALLPARK



Bellevue School District to provide:

- New field turf infield and re-seeded grass outfield.
- One set of 5 row high, 10' long aluminum bleachers on each side.



Newport Baseball is raising money to provide:

- Deluxe bleachers on both sides of diamond and behind home plate.
- Side bleachers 15 rows high X 18' long. Home plate section 10 rows high X 18' long.
- Top 5 rows of bleachers will have individual green colored seats.
- Concrete slabs for all bleacher sections.
- Bleacher risers to be painted green.
- Back and side railings for all sections.
- Covered press box, fully electrically equipped.
- New foul poles.
- New turf for the batting cages and bullpen areas.
